The UK Parliament has been dissolved, and will not meet again until after the General Election that will take place on 12 December. The new parliament is expected to meet for the first time on 17 December formally to elect the Speaker, after which new MPs will be sworn in.

If the Conservative Party win the election, the State Opening of Parliament and the Queen's Speech will follow on Thursday 19 December. If there is a change of Government following the Election it is anticipated that the Queen's Speech will be in January.

Supreme Court: R (on the application of Hemmati and others) v Secretary of State for the Home Department

The five respondents arrived in the United Kingdom illegally and claimed asylum. They had all travelled to the United Kingdom via at least one other member state of the European Union in which they had already claimed asylum. In each case, the Secretary of State requested those states to take responsibility for examining the asylum claims ... Each member state ultimately agreed to that request. Each of the respondents was detained for a period of time pending his or her removal from the United Kingdom ... The respondents challenged the lawfulness of their detention by bringing claims against the Secretary of State for the Home Department. ...

The majority in the Court of Appeal were right to hold that the respondents were wrongfully detained. The respondents are entitled to compensation under domestic law for any loss that the wrongful detention has caused them ... The Secretary of State's submission that the respondents should only be entitled to nominal damages is rejected. ...
